Call for applications to host the 23th GiESCO (2025)

Montpellier, Pech-Rouge, Thessaloniki, Ithaca the 23th of April 2023

Dear colleagues,

We are now at less than 3 months to start the 22th GiESCO meeting to be hold at Ithaca (USA) 17-20 July 2023. If you want to join, you can find all information at: <https://cals.cornell.edu/giesco>.

At Ithaca, we will have to select the institution to held the 23th GiESCO in 2025. To improve the selection process, we will limit to 2 the number of applications to be presented at the general assembly (scheduled Thursday 20th of July PM).

If you want to apply, please send the application to GiESCO's president before 30/06/2023.

The application formatted in a single pdf file of 20 p. max, should include the following items:

- An official letter from the hosting institution, signed by an authorized staff, with a commitment:
 - i) to respect the scientific topics and standards of the GiESCO,
 - ii) to sign an agreement specifying that registration fees will include a lump sum (ca 50 €/full registration) to cover the GiESCO membership to IVES. IVES runs the open access media OenoOne and IVES Conf. Series, which platforms are used to publish both a selection of original papers presented at the GiESCO and the proceedings of the congress.
- Name and position of the convenor and a list of potential members of the organizing committee;
- Venue (description of conference rooms, accommodation options, international connections, etc.);
- Description of higher education/research activities of the hosting institution regarding GiESCO topics;
- List of possible sponsors;
- Options for technical visits during the congress and for post-tours;
- Any other useful information.

The result of the pre-selection will be communicate before the 7th of July 2023, to let enough time to applicants to prepare a slide show. Each presentation (15') will be followed by 5' slot for questions.
